So lets assume that I want to use the user's device type to determine what text I would display in a message to them and maybe how I would present the text differently based on the device. I will be using Firebase Cloud Functions for NodeJS to run the code. I understand it's possible to detect if the user is using a phone or tablet on the phone using phonegap or similar like this var inPhone = navigator.userAgent.match(/iPhone/i)! = null; var inTablet = navigator.userAgent.match(/iPad|Pod/i)! = null; How do I do this to detect if the user is using a laptop?
